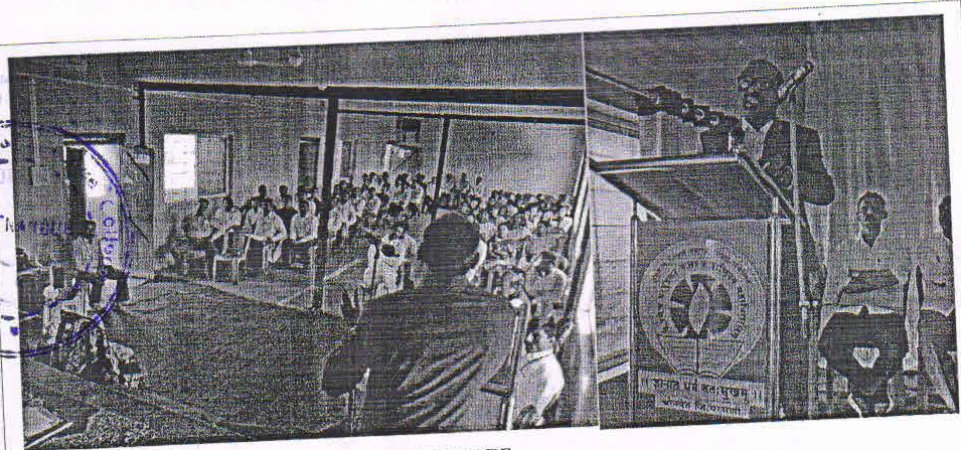


regarding environmental protection. It is expected that each participant will share this idea to their students and society.

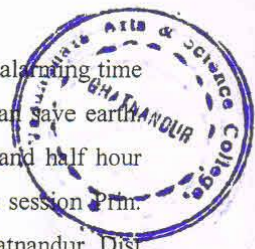

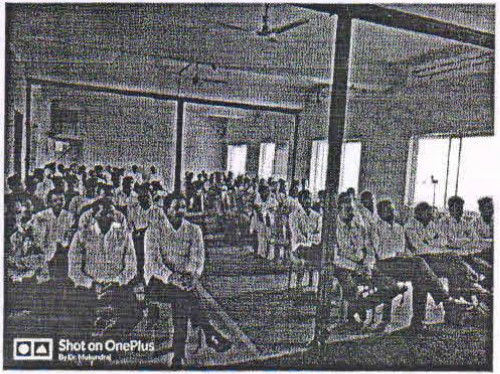
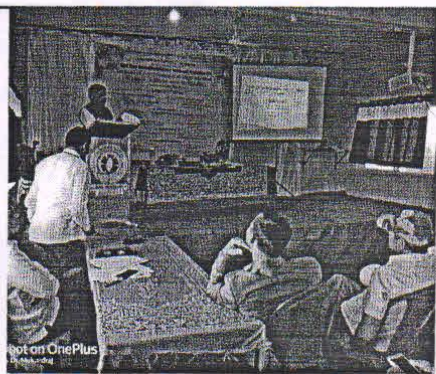
### Session- II – Key Note Address (11.30 to 1.00)

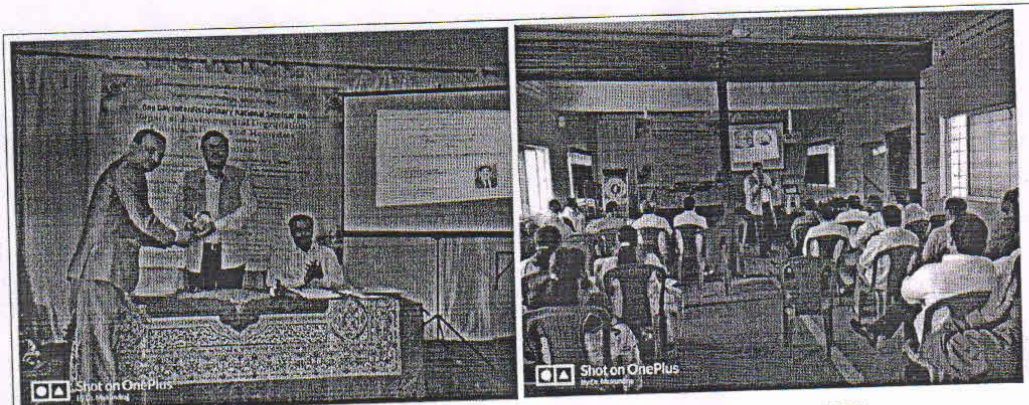

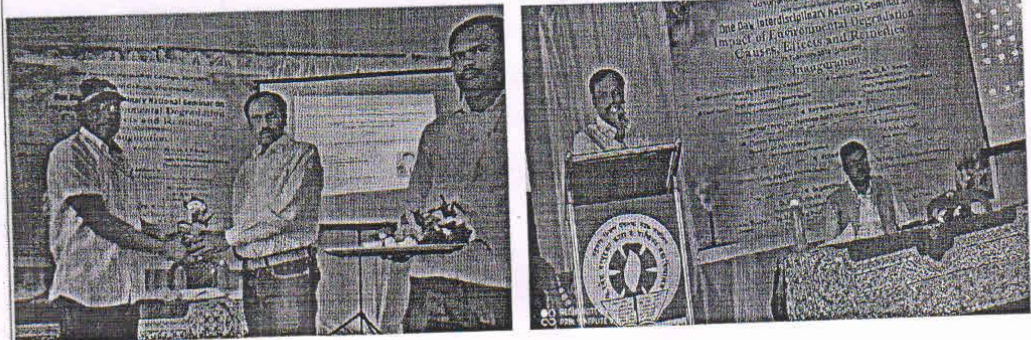


### Session-III- Plenary Session (1.00 to 2.30)

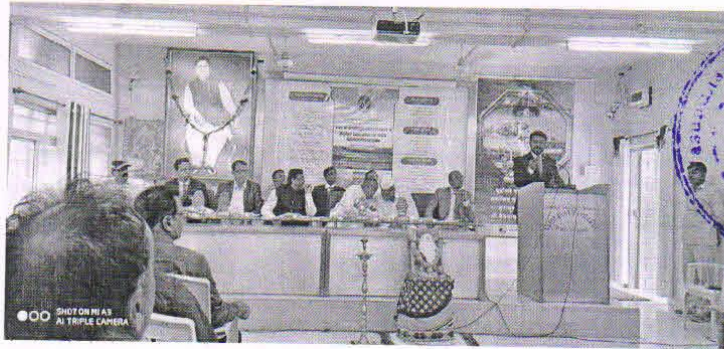

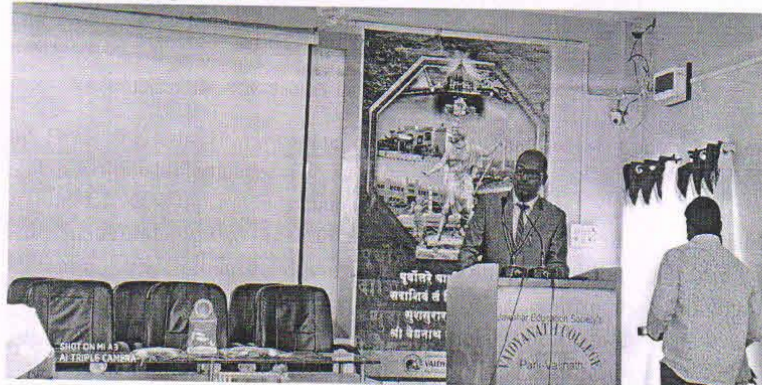

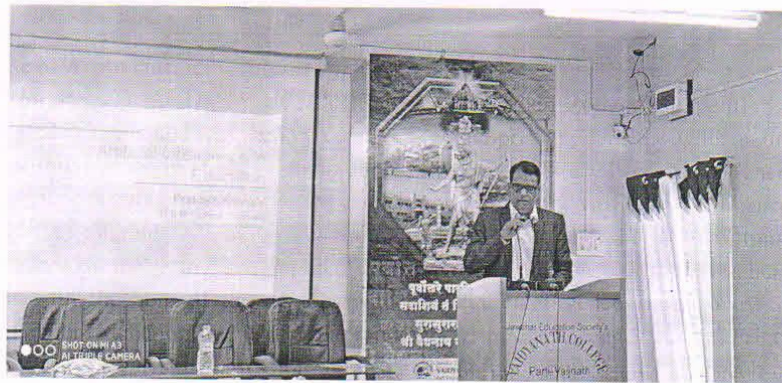
**Key Note Speaker:** Dr. Prakash Khanale (Head, Dept. of Computer Science, DSM, Parbhani)

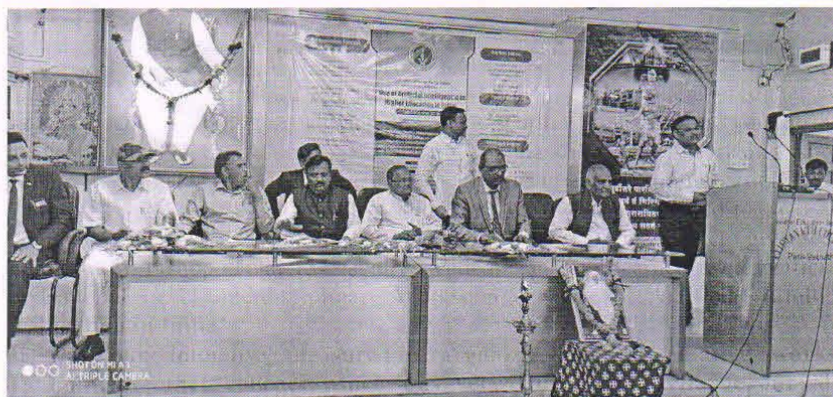
