The male-female ratio is defined as the number of females per 1000 males in the reference population. According to 2011 census in India 940 females for every 1,000 males. It means 60 females is the deficit of Indian male-female ratio. New data from the 2011 Indian census show that there are now 914 girls aged 0-6 years old for every 1,000 boys of the same age. A cultural preference for sons and the increasing availability of prenatal screening to determine a baby's sex have helped contribute to a worsening in the ratio (from 927 in the previous census in 2001), which has been deteriorating rapidly even as the ratio for the population as a whole has improved.



The Seminar was released after the distrubution of the Certificates to participant and by singing the National Anthem.

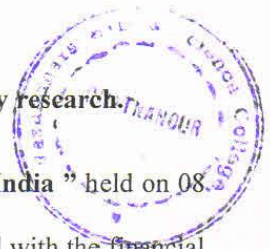

**A Brief note on the Contribution of the seminar the existing body research.**





