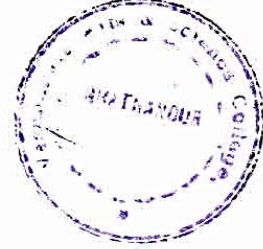


**Report of the ICSSR Sponsored One day National Seminar on

Introduction :

Welfare state is a concept of government where the state plays a key role in the protection and promotion of the economy and social wellbeing of its citizen. It is based on the principle of equality of opportunity, equitable distribution of wealth and public responsibility of those unable to avail themselves of the minimal provisions for a good life,

The constitution of India makes provision of the welfare state in its directive principles in the part IV. These provisions are considered fundamental in the governance of the country. Making it the duty of the state to apply these principles in making laws to establish a just society in the country. The Govt of India followed / implemented this principle in the first four quite reliably. The over this policy got a departure in the early nineties in India in the wake of GATT. It marked an end of the principle of equal opportunity and equitable distribution of wealth. It introduced LPG.

General Agreement of Tariffs and Trade (GATT) was established after world war II in the wake of other new multilateral institutions dedicated to international economic cooperation notably the Bretton Woods institutions known as the world bank and the International monetary fund. A comparable international institution for trade named the international trade organization was successfully negotiated.

This is with reference to your letter of 14th August, 2018.



Kindly note the enclosed terms & conditions for the sanctioned grant & confirm your acceptance of the same.

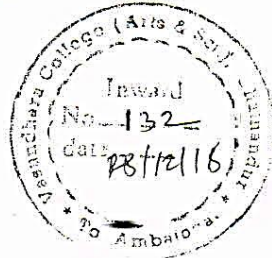
However, your other proposal for financial assistance to organize a seminar on "Politicizing History in India" has not been accepted.
