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



Society's S.R.T.Mahavidyalaya, Ambajogai and Vasundhara Mahavidyalaya, Eshabnende into this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to promote joint educational and industrial collaboration and agree as follows:
ARTICLE 1: SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

ARTICLE 2: DURATION AND EVALUATION
2.1 This MOU shall be in effect for a period of

- 2.2 A joint evaluation of the MOU will be initiated by the designated representatives six (6) months prior to the expiration date. Following the evaluation, the MOU may be renewed and resigned for an additional five (5) year period.
- 2.3 Amendments to this MOU may be requested, in writing, by either party and approved by the authorized signatories.

ARTICLE 3: NON-DISCRIMINATION

The parties agree not to discriminate on the basis of religion, race, creed, national or ethnic origin, sex, age, handicap, political affiliation, sexual orientation, disability or status as a veteran.

ARTICLE 4: COMPLIANCE WITH LAW

The parties specifically intend to comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations as they may be amended from time to time. If any part of this Agreement is determined to violate federal, state, or local laws, rules, or regulations, the parties agree to negotiate in good faith revisions to any such provisions. If the parties fail to agree within a reasonable time to revisions required to bring the entire Agreement into compliance, either party may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party.

ARTICLE 5: FORCE MAJEURE

In the event students are unable to complete the Program due to causes beyond the control of SRT

SRT, including, but not limited to: war; acts of the government; fires; floods; epidemics; quarantine restrictions; strikes, labor disputes or work stoppages; transportation contingency; and freight embargoes; other catastrophes or any similar occurrences beyond SRT, reasonable control, SRT will assist the affected students in finding an alternate site to complete the Program.

ARTICLE 6: Higher Education Authority Rules & Regulations

The parties acknowledge that information (if any) received from SRT regarding students may be protected by the Higher Education Authority Rules & Regulations, and agrees to use such information only for the purpose for which it was disclosed and not to make it available to any third party without first obtaining the Student's written consent. For the purposes of this Agreement, Home Institution shall be deemed to be a "university official."

ARTICLE 7: USE OF NAME

None of the parties shall use the name, logo, likeness, trademarks, image or other intellectual property of either of the other parties for any advertising, marketing, endorsement or any other purposes without the specific prior written consent of an authorized representative of the other party as to each such use. Home Institution may refer to the affiliation with SRT in public information materials regarding the relevant Program. SRT reserves the right to review and

request modification of Home Institution's reference to SRT as necessary. Home Institution may refer to the affiliation with SRT in its brochures and other public information materials having to do with the Program after permission or as per rules and regulations of Higher Education rules and regulations in India.

ARTICLE 8: INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS

ARTICLE 10: WAIVER

The waiver of any breach of any term of this Agreement does not waive any subsequent breach of that or another term of this Agreement.

ARTICLE 11: ASSIGNMENT

No party may assign this Agreement or any rights or obligations under this Agreement to any person or entity without the prior written consent of the other parties. Any assignment in violation of this provision is null and void.

ARTICLE 12: GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be construed and enforced solely pursuant to the laws India without giving effect to the principles of conflicts of laws thereof and the parties agree that this Agreement shall be subject to the sole and exclusive jurisdiction of the state and local courts located in the Maharashtra State. The Parties agree that the foregoing governing law, jurisdiction and forum selections have been concluded as a result of arms-length negotiations and are not overly onerous or burdensome to either Party. If any part of this Agreement is determined to violate federal, state, or local laws, rules, or regulations, the parties agree to negotiate in good faith revisions to any such provisions. If the parties fail to agree within a reasonable time to revisions required to bring the entire Agreement into compliance, either party may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party.

ARTICLE 5: FORCE MAJEURE

In the event students are unable to complete the Program due to causes beyond the control of SRT

SRT, including, but not limited to: war; acts of the government; fires; floods; epidemics; quarantine restrictions; strikes, labor disputes or work stoppages; transportation contingency; and freight embargoes; other catastrophes or any similar occurrences beyond SRT, reasonable control, SRT will assist the affected students in finding an alternate site to complete the Program.

ARTICLE 6: Higher Education Authority Rules & Regulations

The parties acknowledge that information (if any) received from SRT regarding students may be protected by the Higher Education Authority Rules & Regulations, and agrees to use such information only for the purpose for which it was disclosed and not to make it available to any third party without first obtaining the Student's written consent. For the purposes of this Agreement, Home Institution shall be deemed to be a "university official."

ARTICLE 7: USE OF NAME

None of the parties shall use the name, logo, likeness, trademarks, image or other intellectual property of either of the other parties for any advertising, marketing, endorsement or any other purposes without the specific prior written consent of an authorized representative of the other party as to each such use. Home Institution may refer to the affiliation with SRT in public information materials regarding the relevant Program. SRT reserves the right to review and

request modification of Home Institution's reference to SRT as necessary. Home Institution may refer to the affiliation with SRT in its brochures and other public information materials having to do with the Program after permission or as per rules and regulations of Higher Education rules and regulations in India.

ARTICLE 8: INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS

Each party is separate and independent and this Agreement shall not be deemed to create a relationship of agency, employment, or partnership between or among them. Each party understands and agrees that this Agreement establishes an independent contractor relationship and that the agents or employees of each respective party are not employees or agents of any other party.

ARTICLE 9: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Agreement are severable, and if any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will remain in full force and effect.

ARTICLE 10: WAIVER

The waiver of any breach of any term of this Agreement does not waive any subsequent breach of that or another term of this Agreement.

ARTICLE 11: ASSIGNMENT

No party may assign this Agreement or any rights or obligations under this Agreement to any person or entity without the prior written consent of the other parties. Any assignment in violation of this provision is null and void.

ARTICLE 12: GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be construed and enforced solely pursuant to the laws India without giving effect to the principles of conflicts of laws thereof and the parties agree that this Agreement shall be subject to the sole and exclusive jurisdiction of the state and local courts located in the Maharashtra State.
